 - d. Oct-flu-ber-Fest 3 to 7, lots for the kids to do, cost of flu shoots \$35 for shoot, high does is \$65 we will have VFC and CHIP vaccine available.
 - e. Flu clinics are still being booked-flu vaccines are still coming in, clinic still working on HER-we have also moved to KanPay Counter, which will allow clients to pay online. This will allow staff to take payment while out in the field-HD will pick up the 2.5% transaction fees
 - f. Introduction to Andrew Adams-new Preparedness Coordinator
 - i. Karen very important to remind NBAF that we are here and need to stay in touch with them
 - ii. Brenda shared that BRI sends a monthly list of what pathogens are being worked on at BRI
 - iii. HD have had 3 active monitor Ebola cases-HD did except \$26,000.00 for Ebola Preparedness
 - iv. Oct 22nd HD will host a PPE training at Public Works-

 - a. Adam has written a list of community partners the council could contact regarding the 3 issues identified through the CHIP process

 - ii. Transportation-Ann with ATA Buss-new route being made, when this will happen-we should ask Ann to come speak to up-is there data on where high traffic areas are in Manhattan-Stephanie Watts-should be invited as well.

 - vi. Mental Health Providers-Adam feels like this could take the longest time
