REGULATION REMINDERS

With the fall season just around the corner, here are some important reminders:

- ◆ To fight against the Flu and fall colds, be sure that hands are being washed upon entrance to the facility as well as before and after meals as stated in the regulation K.A.R.28-4-116.
- ◆ Prepare your facility for the colder months by ensuring that your heating appliance (if using a freestanding heating appliance) has a protective barrier to protect from burns and if uses combustible fuel is vented to the outside as per regulation K.A.R. 28-4-115(c)(7). The play area temperature should be maintained between 65 and 85 degrees Fahrenheit K.A.R 28-4-115(c)(14).
- ◆ To ensure your kiddos are safe, it is good practice to regularly change the batteries in your smoke detector and carbon monoxide detector. A helpful method in remembering to change the batteries is designating one day a year that is of significance to you for servicing your detectors. For example, daylight savings which ends on November 1, 2015.

K.S.A. 65-531. Immunization information and records; disclosure. On and after July 1, 1996:

- (a) Except as provided further, information and records which pertain to the immunization status of persons against childhood diseases as required by K.S.A. 65-508, and amendments thereto, may be disclosed and exchanged without a parent or guardian's written release authorizing such disclosure, to the following, who need to know such information to assure compliance with state statutes or to achieve age appropriate immunization status for children:
 - (1) Employees of public agencies or departments;
 - (2) health records staff of child care facilities, including, but not limited to, facilities licensed by the secretary of health and environment;
 - (3) persons other than public employees who are entrusted with the regular care of those under the care and custody of a state agency including, but not limited to, operators of day care facilities, group homes, residential care facilities and adoptive or foster homes; and
 - (4) health care professionals.
- (b) Notwithstanding K.S.A. 60-427, and amendments thereto, or any other Kansas statute which provides for privileged information between a patient and a health care provider, there shall be no privilege preventing the furnishing of information and records as authorized by this section by any health care provider.
- (c) Information and records which pertain to the immunization status of persons against childhood diseases as required by K.S.A. 65-508, and amendments thereto, whose parent or guardian has submitted a written statement of religious objection to immunization as provided in K.S.A. 65-508, and amendments thereto, may not be disclosed or exchanged without a parent or guardian's written release authorizing such disclosure.

Upon enrollment, the program can assist you in the following ways:

Mini grants are available for start-up needs, training and education (CDA, college course, and other professional development), and quality improvement needs such as equipment and toys. A One-time bonus upon completion of the CDA (Child Development Associate) is available during grant year 2015.

Visits with Early Childhood Coaches that will include information about health and safety, child development, curriculum and activity ideas, parent communication and assistance in developing quality enhancement plans for your child care.

Access to the toy and book lending library and community play groups.

Access to a behavioral health consultant to assist with challenging child behavior.

Access to a Health Department nurse to assist with health related questions.

Child care scholarships paid directly to the provider.

Assistance in implementing Read, Play and Learn and Zoo Phonics Multisensory Language Arts Program.
